- Relapse after braces

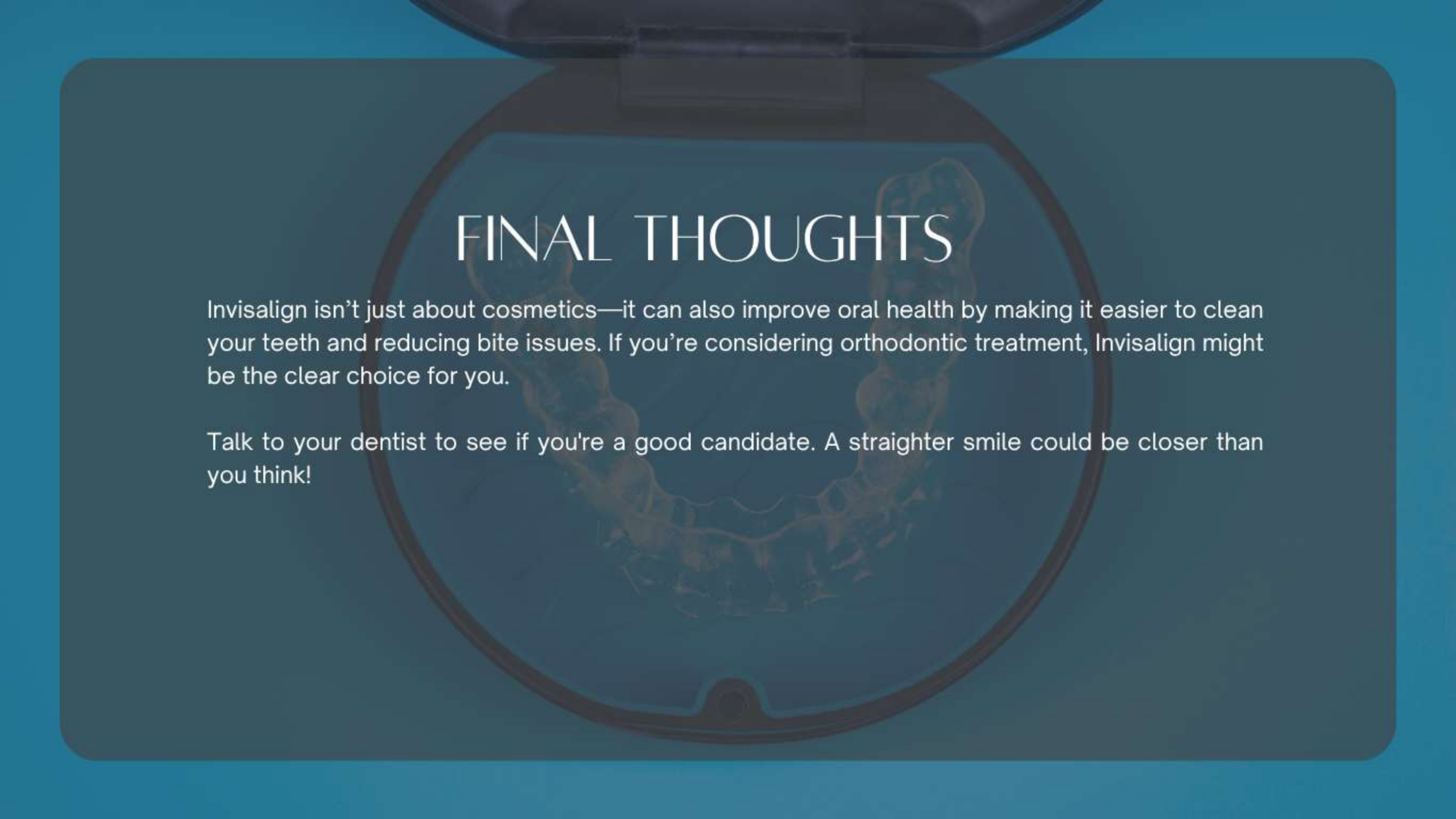
More complex cases might still require traditional braces or other orthodontic treatments, but Invisalign's technology is always advancing.
